Participants will know the environmental conditions affecting the performance of the lift truck and be able to recognize possible dangers. Advanced training on propane handling can be included.

Both employers and employees can face severe penalties if national and industry guidelines are not followed in the operation of forklifts. Workers who operate a reach truck or forklift must be knowledgeable concerning the guidelines about their safe operation.
